Listed below are the priorities that form the PRU Improvement Plan (PIP) for 2016-17. These have been highlighted from self-evaluation and support the continued improvement of BCPRU. Each priority has been broken down into separate objectives that support their completion. This is documented in the full PIP.

Leadership and Management

- 1.1 Carry out an effective academy conversion.
- 1.2 Support others (system leadership).
- 1.3 Leadership development for all staff.
- 1.4 Improve infrastructure to support improved effectiveness.

Teaching, Learning and Assessment

- 2.1 Continue to develop literacy.
- 2.2 Continue to develop numeracy.
- 2.3 Continue to develop the non-core offer.
- 2.4 Review and develop the practical offer.
- 2.5 Continue to develop Marking and Feedback.

Personal Development, Behaviour and Wellbeing

- 3.1 Develop home liaison by the Safer School's Police Officer (SSPO) to support improved safeguarding.
- 3.2 Support the offer for spiritual, moral, social and cultural (SMSC) development and British values by improving community links.
- 3.3 Review and develop the drug & alcohol curriculum offer.
- 3.4 Review the BCPRU Charter offer.
- 3.5 Investigate Charter Marks, with a view to gaining accreditation within agreed areas.
- 3.6 Introduce Signs of Safety to BCPRU.

Outcomes for Pupils
