



# Report on the use of Pupil Premium 2013-14



## **Pupil Premium at Bradford Central PRU in 2013-14**

At Bradford Central PRU (BCPRU), we aim to provide outstanding care, guidance, support and teaching to all of our pupils and are totally committed to enable our most vulnerable pupils to achieve their potential. To support our most vulnerable pupils we receive Pupil Premium funding.

### **What is Pupil Premium funding?**

BCPRU was allocated £3,150 for the 2013-14 academic year. The Pupil Premium value is allocated based on the number of pupils who are or have been entitled to free school meals and the number of pupils who are in care. The number of pupils that are allocated Pupil Premium is calculated as part of the census. For BCPRU, only pupils who are single registered (not dual registered with a school) are allocated Pupil Premium.

For the purpose of this report the academic data being used is for any pupil that would have been entitled to receive Pupil Premium during the 2013-14 academic year; this totalled 98 pupils out of the 200 that attended BCPRU.

### **What have we used the funding for?**

During the last academic year, the Pupil Premium funding has helped to provide:

- Additional reading materials to support improved access to literacy.
- Part funding of Reading Matters to support improved access to reading recovery.
- Rewards trips to promote enjoyment and motivation to succeed.
- Rewards system to promote achievement and motivation.
- Toast and fruit for pupils' breakfast clubs and break times.
- Subsidised ingredients for increased access and achievement in Food Technology.
