Course Content:

The humanities curriculum at BCPRU has been designed to develop core skills needed through the study of Geography and History across both KS3 and KS4, taking into consideration the mixed age range and mixed ability of each class. Units of work encourage class teaching whilst taking into consideration the wide ranges of ability likely in each group.

During their placement students will have the opportunity to complete modules from the following list:

Geography

- Restless Earth: Tectonic Plates, Volcanoes and Earthquakes
- Map Skills

History

- Using Sources: Reliability and Bias; 'Titanic' Case Study
- Trenches in World War One
- Bradford in World War 2

These modules will be delivered through a mixture of whole class teaching, group work and paired work. Assessment will be a combination of self-assessment, peer-assessment and teacher assessment where pupils are encouraged to engage with and respond to any feedback given.
